Pricing

- **Single day simulation** with two experienced moderators for executive education: €6630.
- Discounts are available for purchases of **multiple simulations** at once. For 20 or more simulations: €5130 per session.
- For **education in degree programs** a special price is available of €3750 or €2250 for a simulation guided by a single moderator in cooperation with a teacher.
- For **regular degree programs** the simulation is available as a manual and printable game materials for only €300.

(These prices do not include the location, catering during the day, travel expenses and hours.)

Setting standards is a one-day simulation of a standardization process. Participants acquire hands-on experience, a feeling for the political-economic stakes in standardization, gain insight in standards-related interests and strategies and experience the relevance of procedures in standards processes.

Practical details

A simulation is suitable for 12 to 24 participants and should be guided by 2 moderators. For the participants no technological or juridical background is needed. The simulation takes at least 6 hours of time. You will need:

- ▶ A computer and projector
- ▶ A room of at least 60m² and preferably 80m² with sub-rooms or corners and movable furniture
- ▶ The game materials
